Cut Edge Sealant

Description:

BRITE-n-EZ™ Cut Edge Sealant is a solvent based sealant, provided in a squeeze-bottle, used to seal all cut edges of BRITE-n-EZ™ TPO Membrane where the polyester reinforcement is exposed. TPO membrane, when manufactured, has sealed edges on each side of the roll so that water cannot wick into the scrim. There is exposed scrim at the end of rolls when cut in the factory and when the rolls are cut on the roof. This exposed scrim must be sealed. Although the use of BRITE-n-EZ™ General Purpose Caulk is an acceptable method to seal these seams, some contractors feel the BRITE-n-EZ™ Cut Edge Sealant is a preferred product for aesthetics on the rooftop.

Application Instructions:

- The roofing surface must be clean, dry, smooth, and free of any foreign materials, grease, oil or dirt. Clean with BRITE-n-EZ™ Membrane Cleaner if necessary.
- 2. Apply BRITE-n-EZ™ Cut Edge Sealant after all seams have been spliced with seam tape or heat welded.
- 3. Do not dilute. Wear impervious gloves to prevent contact with skin, safety glasses and protective clothing.
- 4. Do not smoke. Extinguish all flames and pilot lights and turn off stoves, heaters, electric motors and other sources of ignition during use and until all vapors are gone. Do not inhale vapors or spray mist. Have adequate ventilation or use proper fitted respirator.
- Apply a bead of sealant approximately 1/8 to 1/4 inch in diameter to all cut edges of TPO membrane with exposed reinforcement.

Coverage: Coverage rate is 100 lineal feet per pint @

1/8" diameter bead

Storage: Store in original containers on shelves or pallets in a dry climate controlled area between 50° and 80° F. Store as a flammable liquid.

Shelf Life: The shelf life is approximately 6 months if stored in original unopened containers at temperatures not exceeding 80°F. **ROTATE STOCK**.
